As of January, we are looking to hire someone to join our shop team.

There are 8 of us who work in the shop, a small team within the larger business as a whole. We are all trained in all aspects of the day-to-day running of the shop, and so have to have the ability to multi-task, and learn new skills.

Working in the shop involves being on your feet for 8-9 hours per shift.

We start early, setting up the shop, building wonderful produce and bread displays, and liaising with the on-site bakery, and our warehouse and office colleagues to make sure the shop is stocked with the best and what is in stock. This changes every single day.

Serving the customers, checking in deliveries, placing orders, building and maintaining the shop displays and replenishing of stock keeps us busy throughout the day.

There is work on computers required when we have to do price changes on our database, or to create signs for the shop.

We prepare a lot of the home delivery orders throughout the day and so attention to detail in picking orders is required.

As a food business we pride ourselves on our 5 star rating of hygiene and food safety. A lot of what we do involves cleaning and maintaining very high standards to ensure everything is in top notch condition at all times.

Knowing about the products, and being able to advise customers on products is part of the job.

At the end of the day the close down involves cashing up, and cleaning down the whole shop space, leaving it ready to do it all again tomorrow.

For this role, we are looking for someone to work on the following days:

Wednesday 8 to 5

Thursday 9 to 6.30

Friday 9 to 6

Saturday 8 to 5.30.

The start rate for this role is £8/hr. This would hopefully move quite quickly to £9/hr as and when you become proficient in the day-to-day tasks. We want to then train you to the next pay level of £10/hr. This would involve being involved in the ordering side of the shop, and you would be expected to lead a shift. For the right person, you should be able to get to £10/hr within 12 months. From here, over time if you were to progress into managing the shifts, taking on more responsibility and really getting involved in driving the shop and the business as a whole forward, we would increase the pay to reflect this development of role.
